"THREE DAY FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME"

January 23 – 25, 2020



"Three Day Faculty Development Programme" was organised by Don Bosco College Itanagar at Don Bosco Institute for Development and Leadership, Dimapur, Nagaland. The Principal, Faculties and Other Support Staffs of the College participated in the FDP. The programme was held from 23rd till 25th January 2020. The programme consisted of seven sessions on different topics. The details of the sessions taken during the programme are given below:

DAY ONE (23rd JANUARY 2020)

1. SESSION – I & II: Process of NAAC Accreditation & Importance and Functions of IQAC (9:30 am to 12:30 am)

The session started with a brief introduction of the NAAC. Focus was on the importance of NAAC in higher educational institutions and the process to be followed for NAAC accreditation. Further, the resource person gave talk on the importance of documentation and preparation of self study report. The main points discussed in the session are as follows:

- 1. Requirements of certificates and process for IIQA.
- 2. Importance of documentation.
- 3. Relationship, cooperation between management, staff and students.
- 4. Self Study Report: Criterion wise and its importance.
- 5. Peer team visit.
- 6. Other issues related in the process of getting accreditation.

At the end of the presentation, resource person emphasised on cooperation, coordination, determination among the management and staffs in the process of getting NAAC accreditation.

Second session was on the importance and functions of IQAC. During this session, the resource person spoke on the important role of the IQAC in the process of getting NAAC accreditation. Both the sessions ended with the clarification of doubts by the resource person and with the vote of thanks given by Mr. Arun Kumar Sharma, Coordinator, IQAC, DBC Itanagar.

2. SESSION - III: Effective Mentoring System (1:30 pm to 3:00 pm)

The third session was on the effectiveness of the mentoring system on the performance of the students, teacher-student relationship and effective teaching-learning process. The session was on the life of Don Bosco and the Salesian system of education. This session helped us to know the struggles and the challenges faced by Don Bosco since his childhood days till his death. Further, the resource person talked on the Salesian system of education, where his main focus was on two aspects i.e. Love and Kindness. DAY TWO (24th JANUARY 2020)

1. SESSION - I: Anxiety and Panic Disorder (9:30 am to 10:30 am)

The session was geared towards motivating those emotionally and psychologically disturbed students to overcome anxieties and depression and to help them become strong individuals. 2. SESSION - II: Role of Creativity in Education (10:45 am to 12:30 am)
